

- SATCo will follow all Public Health Office Orders as issued by the Government of British Columbia.
- SATCo will adhere to the University of Victoria's policy surrounding Covid-19.
- The following guidelines are subject to change, as per PHO orders and developments in the pandemic.
- As SATCo is an extracurricular, non-essential activity, ALL PERSONNEL involved with SATCo in ANY capacity (Board members, show team members, etc.) MUST be double-vaccinated and provide proof of double vaccination.
- As per PHO orders, the booster shot is not required to be involved with SATCo.
- SATCo's Faculty Liaison will check vaccine passports for SATCo. In extenuating circumstances, vaccine passport checks can be conducted by a different Phoenix faculty member.
- SATCo will designate a specific Board member to organize vaccine passport checks.
- Vaccine passports must be checked via scanner.
- SATCo will keep track of vaccine status for one (1) year for staff and board members and one (1) semester for show teams.
- If an actor/show team member gets sick their return to the production will follow BC health protocols (at time of writing, after five (5) days of being post-symptomatic)

### **Acceptable proof of vaccine**

#### *BC residents*

Personnel must show a valid BC vaccine card that contains a **QR code** that will be scanned upon entry.

Personnel are also expected to show a valid form of ID. This includes:

- BC drivers license or service card
- Passport
- A Uvic OneCard is also accepted if you are a current Uvic student

#### *Out of province residents*

Out of province personnel must show:

- a provincial territorial officially recognized vaccine record
- Valid driver's license, passport, or OneCard if applicable.
